
Tips and tricks for organizing a portable kitchen

Essential items

Large bin —a sturdy, durable, clear bin with a locking lid is best so you can view everything inside. \$27 at Office Depot

We also recommend having 2 smaller bins for other items -1 larger sized to store your cooking and serving supplies in and 1 smaller one for your spices.







Induction stove – this model works very well. The risk of burns is minimized as it's only hot when a magnetic pan is on it. \$70 at Amazon

Serving Supplies

We offer individual servings – hand out individually or load up a tray with a few samples to pass around (you can use a tray or a small cutting board). Serve with mini forks or spoons, or toothpicks. Store spoons, forks, and toothpicks in a small bin to keep sanitary with cooking supplies.

Ingredients

Load your kitchen with a few essential items that you will use often. We will sometimes leave the salt and pepper out for people to add to their sample. It's handy to store your oil, vinegars, and other "wet" ingredients in a mason jar.

We have found that it's easier to do the cooking ahead of time so that when we arrive at the site we just warm up the food. This way we can focus on the clients instead of cooking.
